## TGIF Mini Criteria (Additional guidelines can be found on the application):

- There is a \$500 limit to the amount that the Committee may allocate per project.
- Project proposals may be submitted by UCLA undergraduate students or undergraduate Registered Student Organizations. Individuals and organizations outside of UCLA may not submit proposals.
- Funds will not be allocated retroactively.
- Funds will not be appropriated between the final Committee meeting of Spring Quarter and the first meeting of Fall Quarter.
- Allocations notifications will be sent out two weeks following the application deadline.
